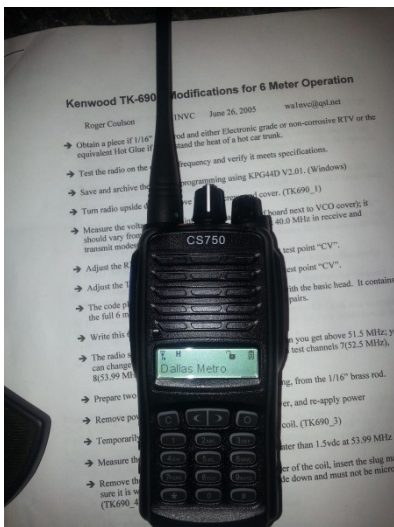


DMR Handheld Radios

-
- TYT MD380/390 - \$119/\$165
 - These radios are the same internally. The only difference is that the MD390 has a stronger case and water-proof battery. It is supposed to be IP67 rated, but tests at IWCE failed when placing the HT into a bucket of water for several hours.
 - Same programming software, cable and codeplug can be used on both radios



-
- Connect Systems CS750 - \$239.99
 - Unlike most radios, this handheld will hold 2000 channels and 64,000+ contacts
 - Same codeplug as the CS800



-
- Zastone DP-880 - \$179.99
 - Subsidiary of Kirisun
 - Same software as TYT, but codeplugs aren't interchangeable
 - Variable channel selector – more than 16 channels per zone

- Puxing PX-820 - \$219.99
 - Motorola clone – interchangeable speaker-mics and ear-pieces
 - Fantastic audio and receiver
