## **DMR Handheld Radios**



MD380 most common in Houston

- TYT MD380/390 \$119/\$165
  - These radios are the same internally. The only difference is that the MD390 has a stronger case and water-proof battery. It is supposed to be IP67 rated, but tests at IWCE failed when placing the HT into a bucket of water for several hours.
  - o Same programming software, cable and codeplug can be used on both radios



- Connect Systems CS750 \$239.99
  - Unlike most radios, this handheld will hold 2000 channels and 64,000+ contacts
  - Same codeplug as the CS800



- Zastone DP-880 \$179.99
  - Subsidiary of Kirisun
  - o Same software as TYT, but codeplugs aren't interchangeable
  - o Variable channel selector more than 16 channels per zone

- Puxing PX-820 \$219.99
  - Motorola clone interchangeable speaker-mics and ear-pieces
  - Fantastic audio and receiver



- <u>Tera TR-7400 \$279.99</u>
